

PRELIMINARY

I am happy to find BPSCMV's Annual Report for the year 2014-15. This is the first time that various activities listed in the current issue of Annual Report, during the year, have been concerned members of the University Council have been most satisfied and glorified. It is, therefore, our common achievement in the last one year reflects on the strong and weak areas of the campus.

Owing to its general to Gurukul traditions, BPSCMV has been enabling both the students and faculty of students studying here. Besides fostering academic merits, we provide opportunities to develop good citizens with high moral character. The unique blend of tradition and modernity is achieved through various programmes offered by the university through its affiliated degree and certificate colleges, institutions and Centers of Excellence like Centre for Gender Studies, Interface and Research (ICIR), Centre for India-Asia Studies (CIAS), Learning Resource Centre (LRC) and Human resource development centre. BPSCMV's recognition as international university has been well received due to its active MOUs with international agencies like United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), Institute of Company Secretaries of India (ICSI), Ministry of Health, Government, USA. Through these MOUs both the students and staff get opportunities to expand their knowledge of the latest developments in the concerned domains. Besides the conventional academic activities, the university has been actively involved in the national initiatives of social change like *hasi Sadak Yojna*, *Bal Sakshat Padakshat*, *National Unity Day* etc. Our sustained efforts in this direction have resulted in BPSCMV being awarded 'Emerging Women University of India Award' and 'Clean Campus Award' by the Ministry of Cleanliness, Education and Research, Delhi. In order to provide good environment for various construction activities have been completed in the last year, and the new building of BPSCMV has been fortunate to receive ungrated financial and administrative support from the Government of Haryana. SECTION – I

THE UNIVERSITY

Brief Introduction

Today's Bhagat Phool Singh Mahila Vishwavidyalaya is the 'dream come true' of Bhagat Phool Singh Ji (1885-1942) who established a *Gurukul* for girls at Khanpur Kalan in 1936. After the demise of Bhagat Phool Singh his daughter Subhashini not only took control of *Gurukul* but worked vigorously in expanding the *Gurukul* in terms of its various constituent institutions like BPS Memorial Girls' College (1967), BPS College of Education (1968), MSM Ayurvedic College (1973), BPS Mahila Polytechnic (1984), TIG Bhainswal Kalan (1999) and PSD Girls' Law College (2003).

The State Government upgraded the erstwhile *Gurukul* to the status of a University exclusively for women in August 2006 and christened it as Bhagat Phool Singh Mahila Vishwavidyalaya, which happens to be the first State Women University of North India. Since then BPSMV has undergone a complete transformation; the *Gurukul* started with only three girls has turned into a modern university with approximately 6500 girls on its rolls studying in various job oriented programmes from KG to PhD level. The university has established its two regional centres at Kharai (Jind) and Lula Ahir (Rewari).

Special Centres

Centre for Indic-Asian Studies (CIAS): BPSMV is the first and only university in Haryana to be awarded prestigious Area Study Centre on Indic Asian Studies of UGC which carry out research on issues related to Indo-Asian knowledge systems. CIAS has operationalized its dedicated participative website www.sthaneshwaranidh.ac.in which contains information on various themes pertaining to Indo-Asian culture and traditions.

Centre for Society University Interface and Research (CSUIR): It was established in August 2010 with an aim to bridge the disconnection between University and society. It organizes courses and activities which are of direct relevance to the rural community and to formulate schemes that recover traditional good agricultural practices and sustain and conserve the vast knowledge reservoir of rural women. The Centre offers innovative courses in three core areas viz. Integrated Energy Resource Management, Microfinance Practices and Folk Medicine.

Human Resource Development Centre (formerly Academic Staff College): HRDC at BPSMV offers faculty development programmes to in-service college and university teachers and administrators. It organized refresher courses, orientation courses and workshops during the last year.

Learning Resource Centre (LRC): The Learning Resource Centre has six state-of-the-art Language Labs, equipped with latest technological software which helps in effective learning of language skills which are compulsory to learn for all the enrolled students. LRC also imparts training & guidance for appearing in International English proficiency examinations like Business English Certificate (BEC). The LRC is also the research centre for American interns from St. Catherine University from USA to complete their internship programme.

Staff Training and Research Institute for Teaching of English (STRITE): STRITE has been established as an autonomous Institute of BPSMV for imparting training in effective teaching of English & operation of language laboratory to school & college teachers.

University Placement and Counseling Cell (UPACC): It provides free placement and counseling guidance to all the students.

University Centre for Judicial Services (UCJS): It has been established in the University for imparting coaching and guidance for entering into judicial services.

Central Library: The Central Library has a stock of approximately 110000 books. It has approximately 7000 users and subscribes to 55 National and International Journals, 100 Magazines & Periodicals and 22 Newspapers (Hindi & English). The library provides access to JSTOR, OXFORD UNIVERSITY PRESS, WILEY INDIA, SPRINGER LINK, TAYLOR AND FRANCIS, JCCC, HEIN ONLINE, WEST LAWS, and MANUPATRA through UGC INFONET Digital Libraries Consortium. The university has the membership of Developing Library Network (DELNET), Delhi. The central library organized a workshop on Institutional Repository (IR) scheme.

International MOUs: BPSMV has signed MOUs with UNDP, ICSI, Kwangwoon University, South Korea and St. Catherine University, USA.

University Teaching Departments & Constituent Institutions

PROGRAMMES OFFERED

STUDENTS' WELFARE DEPARTMENT

The Students' Welfare Department:

1. Dean, Students' Welfare was established in April 09, 2012. Dean, Students' Welfare is a statutory officer of the rank of a Professor with a rich academic experience and a record of mature conciliatory interaction with students and carries with them a deep understanding of their day-to-day problems and common issues. Dean, Students' Welfare

2. DR/DDR & HR (Deptt. Representative/Deputy Deptt. Representative), have appointed various student representatives under department, class and hostel level by the higher authority of the BPSMV regarding the solution for the problems of the students. Department Representative (DR) represents department, class representative represents class and hostel representative and Chief Prefect represents hostel. This is very good platform for enriching cooperation unity leadership among students and their department. This will curve out future leaders and they will be able to lead our country well. In this connection meeting has called by the BPSMV authority with the students regarding the direct discuss on the problems/suggestions in the BPSMV Campus for the students. The BPSMV authority have listen the problems of the students and sort out the same at deptt/branch level and the selected suggestion given by the students have in roll as per decision of the BPSMV authority.
3. **Charity Fund:** As per rules and regulations approved by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor for financial assistance from the Charity Fund of BPSMV, the case of needy students on prescribed application form alongwith all requisite documents duly scrutinized by the committee is /has to be forwarded by the concerned HOD to the office of the DSW by due date i.e. 30th April of every year. The Financial assistance up to maximum Rs. 10,000/- per student per year may be given to two students of each department on the occasion of 15th August of every year. The financial assistance to the needy/poor students from the Charity Fund account of the BPSMV Rs. 70,000/- (2013) and Rs. 60,000/- (2014) have been given to the weaker sanction by the DSW office.
4. **Study Tour Policy for the BPSMV Students:** This Policy has been approved by the higher authority of the BPSMV. It is pertinent to mention here that it has been also approved by the Hon'ble Vice-chancellor of the BPSMV in the meeting dated 25.10.2013 that 50% travelling allowance will be borne by the University towards Education Tour of the students. One male and one female teacher will accompany the tour as teacher Incharges for 20 students. TA/DA to the concerned teachers will be paid by the University. So the 50% travelling allowance will be borne by the University towards Education Tour of the students (Half of the actual bus fair

or half of rail fare up to limit of 2nd class sleeper). One male and one female teacher (If the female teacher is not available in the Dept then the wife of the male teacher may be allowed without any financial benefits) will accompany the tour as teacher incharge for 20 students. TA/DA to the concerned teachers will be paid by the University as per rules.

5. **Grievance & Redressal Cell** of the BPSMV is running under the office of DSW. In this connection many suggestion boxes have tagged in every Hostel & the Shopping Centre of the BPSMV for the suggestions/complaints of students. In every fifteen days these suggestion boxes are open by the DSW office to receive the suggestion/complaint. The same are forward to the concerned deptt./branch/office for the solution of the complaint with an ATR to the DSW office within 7 days. After receiving the compliance report from the concerned departments the DSW office has summarized the suggestion/complaints and forward to the higher authority of the BPSMV for the permanent solution of complaint. In this connection 218 complaints have been resolved by the DSW office under the intimation of the BPSMV authority. In this regard CP pages 680 & NP pages 63 have been correspondences by the DSW office.


