At the outset, the Hon'ble Vice- Chancellor extended a warm welcome to the members and placed the proposal before the Committee with regard to revised estimates for the year 2013-14 and Budget Estimates for the year 2014-15.

The minutes of the 6th meeting of Finance Committee held on 28.03.2014 were confirmed.

2. To consider & approve the income and expenditure for the financial year 2013-14

The Finance Committee considered and approved the income and expenditure for the financial year 2013-14.

- To consider & approve the Revised Budget of the university for the year 2013-14 and budget proposals for the financial year 2014-15
 - a) The agenda was discussed in detail. The revised estimates and the budget was approved with the condition that a grant of Rs. 33.00 crores provided in the budget for the year 2014-15 is sufficient to meet their recurring and non recurring expenditure projected in the budget.
 - b) The deficit of Rs. 24.00 crores shown in the Budget Estimates for the year 2014-15 should be met out of corpus fund/ fixed deposits with the University to the tune of Rs. 24.00 crores. As such no further grant would be given to the University to meet the deficit shown in budget.
 - c) The University will prepare a capital expenditure plan keeping in view the growth of the University over the next five years in consultation with the administrative department and the same be got approved from the Executive Council of the University and thereafter from the Finance Committee. If need be, a Chartered Accountant may be hired to prepare vision/plan document on the basis of which the capital expenditure be prepared on year to year basis.

4. To consider & approve the grant of Rs. 311.20 lacs received from UGC for construction of Library Building will be transferred to PWD B&R Deptt.

Considered and approved by the Finance Committee that grant of Rs. 311.20 lacs received from UGC be transferred to PWD B&R Deptt. for construction of Library Building. The total estimated cost of the project in 1st phase is Rs. 750.00 lacs and out of the estimated expenditure of Rs.750.00 lacs, Rs. 673.50 lacs will be met from UGC Grant and the balance amount of Rs 76.50 lacs will be met out from State Govt/ University funds.

To consider & approve the grant of Rs. 406.70 lacs released by the State Govt. is being transferred to PWD B&R for construction of Sports Stadium.

Considered and approved the estimate cost of Rs. 805.86 lacs for construction of Sports Stadium and also approved to transfer the amount of Rs. 406.70 to PWD B&R Deptt.



Bhagat Phool Singh Mahila Vishwavidyalaya is the manifestation of the dream seen by the legendary, saintly figure Bhagat Phool Singh ji, who established a Gurukul, exclusively for girls at Khanpur Kalan in 1936. Notwithstanding the vehement opposition to Bhagat Phool Singhji's endeavor to educate girls, Gurukul Khanpur Kalan turned out to be a 'Mecca' for girls' education. Barring few non progressive sections of society, everybody including the eminent personalities like Sir Chhotu Ram of those times helped in evolving Gurukul Khanpur Kalan into a centre of excellence for girls' education. Owing to his extraordinary interest in women's education Shri Bhupinder Singh Hooda, the Honorable Chief Minister of Haryana upgraded the erstwhile Gurukul to the status of a University exclusively for women in August 2006 and christened it as Bhagat Phool Singh Mahila Vishwavidyalaya, (hereafter referred as BPSMV) the first State Women University of North India.

Since its inception in August 2006, Bhagat Phool Singh Mahila Vishwavidyalaya has earned its place of 'university with a difference' in the arena of higher education.. To start with the bare minimum requirements of a university, BPSMV has undergone a complete transformation; a 75 years old Gurukul started with only three girls has turned into a modern university with approximately 7000 girls on its rolls and juxtaposing tradition with modernity.

Bhagat Phool Singh Mahila Vishwavidyalaya is spread over lush green, pollution free 500 acres of land. There are two teaching blocks housing various teaching departments of the university, an administrative block, a multipurpose hall and the School of Engineering and Sciences. There are several constituent colleges viz. BPS Memorial Girls' College, BPS Institute of Teacher Training & Research, Department of Laws, BPS Mahila Polytechnic and MSM Institute of Ayurveda. Also there are two Schools offering courses in all school subjects both in Hindi and English medium.

Centre for Society - University Interface and Research (CSUIR)

Realizing the need to create and sustain a collaborative framework between the university and society, CSUIR has been established by BPSMV. The Centre offers innovative courses in three areas viz. Integrated Energy Resource Management, Microfinance Practices and Folk Medicine.

Academic Staff College

BPSMV is the youngest university in India to get the Academic Staff College in a record time of two years of its establishment. Since its inauguration on 14th August 2009 the Academic Staff College has organized many Orientation Programmes, refresher Courses and Workshops for college/ university teachers from all over the country.

Learning Resource Centre

Learning Resource Centre (Language Labs) is an independent central facility of the University, responsible for providing training in communication skills to all the students enrolled with the university. It also acts as a platform where learners are groomed for Soft & Interpersonal skills. The Learning Resource Centre has six state-of-the-art Language Labs, equipped with latest technological software which helps in effective learning of language skills which are compulsory to learn for all the enrolled students. Besides this, LRC also imparts training & guidance for appearing in International English proficiency examinations like BEC, IELTS, TOEFL conducted by University of Cambridge, ESOL examinations department and other international agencies.

Staff Training and Research Institute for Teaching of English (STRITE)

Staff Training and Research Institute for Teaching of English (STRITE) has been established as an Autonomous Institute in LRC for imparting training in effective teaching of English & operation of language lab to school & college teachers. So far STRITE has conducted 10 Teacher Training Programmes.

Personality Development Centre

A Personality Development Centre has been established in the University for grooming the all-round personality traits of the students. It prepares the students for facing job interviews, making presentations etc.

University Centre for Judicial Services

Hostels & Faculty Houses

The university provides the best hostel facilities to the resident students. The hostels are newly constructed, equipped with state of the art amenities like mess, solar water heaters, recreational facilities library etc. the rooms with both double and single occupancy are offered to the students. There are 15 hostels with modern facilities with a capacity of **3500 residents**. The university has constructed new 95 faculty houses in addition to 131 old houses.

University Library

The University has one Central Library and Departmental Libraries in all the Institutes / Departments. The Central Library was established in 2007 and covers 9150 square feet and has a stock of approximately 6772 books. The Library remains opens from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. on all working days except Sundays and Gazetted holidays. 867 books and 5669 books added in Central Library and Departmental Libraries respectively during the financial year 2011-12. The Central Library has approximately 7000 Users. The Central Library subscribes to 82 National and International Journals, Magazines & Periodicals and 20 Newspapers (Hindi & English). The Library also subscribes 3 Electronic Journals (IEEE, ASTM and BENTHEM). INFLIBNET provided JSTOR, OXFORD UNIVERSITY PRESS, WILEY INDIA, SPRINGER LINK, TAYLOR AND FRANCIS, JCCC, HEIN ONLINE, WEST LAWS, MANUPATRA free of cost through UGC INFONET Digital Libraries Consortium. 8 E-Journals of Sage can also be accessed as the library subscribed the hardcopies of these journals. The University's website has a homepage of University Library and E-Resources can be accessed from University Library home page of Digital Library.

Games & Healthcare

The university has well developed facility for both outdoor and indoor games like Badminton, Volleyball, Kabaddi, Lawn Tennis, Judo, Basketball etc. A state of art **Gymnasium** has been established in the university. A well developed Ayurvedic College and a 110 bed Hospital are situated on the campus providing round the clock medical facility to the patients from within the university and the neighboring villages. In addition to that, a Medical College for girls supported with 500 bed super specialty hospital has become operational.
