iv) Horital leave may be combined with any other leave subject to the limit of total period of 180 days. Hospital leave shall not be debited to the leave account of the employee concerned.

10. Leave not due:

Leave not due may be granted to a permanent employee on production of medical certificate or otherwise by the Executive Council on full pay up to maximum of 180 days during the entire period of service.

The leave 'not due' is intended to be regarded as an advance of leave when the employee's Note: leave account shows nil/debit balance and its grant should, therefore, be limited to the amount which shall be earned by the subsequent duty. The leave 'not due' may in no case be granted unless the sanctioning authority is satisfied that, as far as can be reasonably foreseen, the employee shall return to duty and earn it. Such leave shall be debited against the half pay leave which the employee may earn subsequently.

An employee to whom leave 'not due' is granted shall not be permitted to tender his resignation from the service so long as the debit balance in his leave accounts is wiped off by active service or he refunds amount paid to him as salary for the period not so earned. In a case where retirement is unavoidable on account of reason of ill-health incapacitating the employee for further service refund of leave salary for the period of leave still to be earned may be waived off by the Executive Council. Provided further that the Executive Council may, in any other exceptional cases, waive, for reasons to be recorded, the refund of leave salary for the period of leave still to be earned.

11. Extra ordinary Leave:

- i) An employee (whether permanent or temporary) may be granted extraordinary leave by the competent authority:
- a) when no other leave is admissible; or
- b) when other leave is admissible, the employee applies in writing for the extra-ordinary leave for any special reason.
- ii) Extra-ordinary leave shall be without pay and allowances. However, House Rent Allowance shall be admissible for a period not exceeding first four months at the rate at which an employee was drawing before proceeding on such leave provided he has not been in employment elsewhere during that period. The leave shall not ordinarily exceed one year at a time.

Extra-ordinary leave shall not count for increment, except in the following cases:-

- a) The sanctioning authority is satisfied that such leave was taken by an employee on account of illness or for any other cause beyond his control provided that the employee has not other kind of leave to his credit;
- b) Leave is granted for the purpose of higher studies and research; and

c) Leave is granted to accept an invitation to a teaching post or fellowship or research-cum-teaching · post or an assignment for administrative or technical or academic work of importance. Provided that the maximum total period for which such leave is granted shall not ordinarily, exceed three years and in exceptional cases such leave may be extended so that the total period of leave, during the whole tenure of service of an employee does not exceed five years. Provided further that the benefit of increment for a period upto three years of extra-ordinary leave may be allowed for accepting such assignments and for the purpose of higher studies and research anywhere in India or abroad.

The word 'Invitation' of the above rule may include both a direct offer sent by the host institution and any offer received in response to an application or bio-data sent by the employees through the University to any Institution in India or abroad.

Extension would be permitted only in rare and exceptional cases, subject to the satisfaction of the Vice-Chancellor.

12. * DUTY LEAVE

- i. Duty Leave of the maximum of 30 days in an academic year may be granted for the following:
- a. Attending conferences, congresses, symposia and seminars on behalf of the university or with the permission of the university;
- b. Delivering lectures in institutions and universities at the invitation of such institutions or universities received by the university, and accepted by the Vice-Chancellor, working in another Indian or foreign university, any other agency, institution or organization, when so deputed by the

- d. For performing any other duty for the university;
- i. The duration of leave should be such as may be considered necessary by the sanctioning authority
- ii. The leave may be granted on full pay. Provided that if the teacher receives a fellowship or honorarium or any other financial assistance beyond the amount needed for normal expenses, he/she may be sanctioned duty leave on reduced pay and allowances.
- iii. Duty leave may be combined with earned leave, half pay leave or extraordinary leave.
- iv. Duty leave should be given also for attending meetings in the UGC, DST, etc. where a teacher invited to share expertise with academic bodies, government or NGO.

6. That the DGHE vide memo No. 18/93-2014 UNP(1) dated 21.10.2014 informed the University that CAS policy for faculty in MSM Institute of Ayurveda is not applicable. Further, the University has recently vide letter reference No. MSM/Inst./Ayu./2022/425 dated 26.05.2022 has sent a proposal to DGHE for considering the applicability of dynamic assured career progression scheme (DACP) issued by Ministry of Ayush, Govt. of India, to staff of MSMIA, BPSMV, Khanpur Kalan.

Earlier, DGHE vide Memo No. 5/13-2016 UNP (1) dated 01.09.2017 informed the Vice-Chancellor of the University that further appointments of faculty in MSM Institute of Ayurveda be made after framing policy with the consultation of Finance Department, Govt. of Haryana.

Sh. Ajay informed that the University has appointed Dr. Deshmukh Prasant as Assistant Professor vide appointment letter dated 28.12.2017 under direct recruitment as per qualifications laid down by CCIM. Further the Committee was informed that another Assistant Professor has been appointed on contractual basis in MSM Institute of Ayurveda in 2021 a per qualification laid down by CCIM.

The Committee was informed that the University vide letter reference No. BPSMV/EN-I/21/1233 dated 12.07.2022 intimated to DGHE that there are three vacant posts of Professor in MSM Institute of Ayurveda which may be allowed to fill up under direct recruitment as per CCIM norms and DGHE vide memo No. 18/59-2014 UNP (1) (E-Office 638557) dated 23.08.2022 has permitted to the University to fill up the three posts of Professor in MSM Institute of Ayurveda through direct recruitment.
- 8. The Committee sought details of all the posts of Professor sanctioned by the state government in MSM Institute of Ayurveda including posts sanctioned under rationalization policy. The Committee was informed that rationalization that four posts of Professors in MSMIA were sanctioned by the State Govt. under rationalization policy vide Memo No. 18/203-2007 UNP (2) dated 27.02.2009 and these four posts were allocated to Dr. K.V. Singh, Dr. Delel Singh, Dr. Shakuntala Chaudhary and Dr. Nirmala Chaudhary respectively and all these Professors were promoted to the post of Professor by erstwhile management before establishment of the University.

Further, the Committee was informed that five posts of Professors and Nine posts of Readers for MSMIA were sanctioned by the State Govt. vide Memo No. 18/328-2007 UNP (1) dated 17.01.2014 and out of these five posts of Professors, four posts were downgraded to the posts of Associate Professors in MSMIA by the state govt. on request of the University vide Memo No. 18/328-2007 UNP (1) dated 11.11.2016. The Committee was informed that there is one vacant post of Associate Professor in MSMIA.

The Committee after careful analysis of above mentioned and all relevant facts is of the considered opinion that out of total five posts of Professors in MSMIA, one post of Professor is occupied by Dr. Mahesh Dadhidch who has been recruited under direct recruitment and another Professor named Dr. Vijay Swarup Kaushik was also recruited under direct recruitment who had retired.

Subject: Concealment of material facts by Dr. Reena Rani at the time of her appointment as Lecturer/Assistant Prof. in 2007-08 and promotion for the grant of AGP of Rs. 8000/- in 2017

Hon'ble Sir,

In continuation to my earlier letter dated 20th July, 2017 diary no.1438 on subject cited above. I am again writing you to intimate that she has done MEd in 2006 and M.Phil in 2007 and PhD in Hindi in 2007. Therefore, she has done two parallel degrees with PhD in Hindi which the apparent violation of the UGC and Distance Education Council norms. She concealed these facts in her application form and got the benefits of selection and promotion subsequently.

In this letter I want to acquaint the following facts to your good self:

- 1. In a reply to RTI application filed by my husband Sh. Sandeep Kumar, it has been intimated by the Gurukul Kangri Vishvavidhalya Haridwar that neither she has informed about her admission to M.Ed and M.Phil programmes, done parallel/simultaneously with her PhD-Hindi Degree, to the authorities of said university nor they permit to do two or more parallel degrees. The copy of the RTI application and reply given by GurukulKangri Vishvavidhalya Haridwar is enclosed herewith. The information on not allowing the parallel degrees is covered under point 10 and 11 of the RTI application and reply inter-alia. (Annexure-1)
- 2. I have yesterday received some documents from BPSMV, K.K under RTI Act wherein the University has supplied some papers which shows that Dr Reena Rani was given an NOC by Gurukul Kangri Vishvavidhalya Haridwar for doing parallel degrees along with PhD.-Hindi, which is in contrary to information provided by Gurukul Kangri Vishvavidhalya Haridwar to me. In addition, the said NOC is without any reference no. In first instance, the NOC appears bogus and fake. It is very pertinent to note here that the RTI reply the undersigned husband received from Gurukul Kangri Vishvavidhalya Haridwar is in contrary to the letters submitted by Dr Reena Rani and letter received by Assistant Registerar BPS Khanpur Kalan, Sonepat(reference.no.Acad/Res/2018-19)Dated 30/01/2018.(Annexure 2-4

for ready reference). It is requested that either personally or through email the Registrar may verify the truth of the facts so that truth only prevails.

- 3. The undersigned has observed the difference in signature of Assistant Registrar Academics (GurukulKangriVishvavidhalyaHaridwar) on reply to my husband RTI reply and the and letter received by Assistant Registrar BPS Khanpur Kalan,Sonepat (reference.no.Acad/Res/2018-19)Dated 30/01/2018. The mismatch of signature is apparent.
- 4. Moreover my husband Sh. Sandeep Kumar has filed an RTI application to UGC regarding the rules for doing parallel degrees. The UGC, vide Public Notice Dated 15/01/2016 has specifically stated that "The commission has sought the comments of the statutory councils. The responses, so far, received don't endorse the idea of allowing the students to pursue two degrees simultaneously. Therefore, the universities shall conduct their programmes in accordance with the First Degree and Master's Degree regulations 2003 prescribed by UGC and also follow the norms and parameters prescribed by the Statutory Council concerned, wherever relevant" (Annexure-5). Therefore, two degrees cannot be done simultaneously. Dr. Reena has taken the benefits illegally by hiding the vital facts. Her services need to be terminated immediately.
- 5. Dr Reena Rani has not only done one degree with a PhD Hindi degree rather she has done two degrees i.e MEd and M.Phil with a PhD Degree. So her case don't even fall into the category of dual degrees. She simultaneously has done three degrees, MEd in 2006 and M.Phil in 2007 and PhD in Hindi from 2005-2007 and taken benefits of the same for getting the job.
- 6. In addition, Dr Reena has submitted an RTI reply from CDLU Sirsa but even in that letter there is no clarity as the fact quoted from the HBI 2006-07 page no. 10 under the clause eligibility criteria and page no 21 states "Dual degree in distance education is allowed with one regular course" (the course can be only a certificate/diploma not another degree). So no clarity if the university allows one regular degree programme with one distance mode degree (Annexure-6).
- 7. The Distance Education bureau formerly Distance Education Council, an autonomous body of UGC, notified vide its notification F. No. DEC/NOTIFICATIONS/ 40.5.1.5/2012/15983-16229dated 01.11.2012 that "Two degree programme cannot be allowed to be pursued simultaneously (Annexure-7)".

In view of above said facts you are requested to kindly take appropriate action on my earlier application since the appointment and earlier promotions of Dr. Reena

Rani are in violation of UGC/ State Govt./ Universities/DEC rules and regulations. It appears that Dr. Reena has managed the Gurukul Kangri University officials and got favourable documents to save herself otherwise the said documents shown to be issued by Gurukul Kangri Vishvavidhalya may be forged and fake; only a through enquiry by experts from the govt. panel can clear the picture or the matter may be handed over to police for thorough investigation.

I am sending it directly to you since Dr. Suman Dalal, Chairperson, is helping Dr. Reena to settle the case illegally in her favour.

Enquiry Report

This refers to a complaint by Dr Varuna, Assistant Professor, ITTR, BPSMV, Khanpur Kalan against Dr Reena Rani, Assistant Professor (Hindi), ITTR, BPSMV Khanpur Kalan submitted to the Vice Chancellor, BPSMV, Khanpur Kalan (See Annexure-I). A fact finding two member enquiry committee was constituted by the Vice-Chancellor, BPSMV, Khanpur Kalan vide office order BPSMV/ET-I/19/2480-84 dated 04.07.2019 (See Annexure-II). Following are the members of the Committee:

The Main Points of the Complaint

- 1. Dr Reena Rani, Assistant Professor (Hindi), ITTR, BPSMV Khanpur Kalan concealed material facts at the time of her selection to the post of Lecturer (teaching of Hindi) in March 2008 and thereafter for the grant of AGP of Rs. 8000/-.
- 2. At the time of her applying for the said post, Dr Reena Rani was M.Ed and M.Phil in Education and Ph.D in Hindi. (See Annexure –III)
- 3. As per the application for the said post, Dr Reena Rani had completed M.Ed. in 2006 and M.Phil in 2007.
- 4. At the time of her appointment she was M.Phil in Education and Ph.D in Hindi.
- 5. Dr Reena Rani deliberately concealed the fact regarding the year of award of her Ph.D. degree in Hindi.
- 6. Dr Reena Rani concealed and misrepresented the facts because she has done two parallel Degrees with Ph.D in Hindi in violation of UGC Norms.
- 7. Dr Reena Rani did M.Ed in 2006, M.Phil in Education in 2007 and Ph.D Hindi in 2007.
 - 8. Dr Reena Rani took the advantage of promotion to the Grade pay of Rs 7000/- in March 2012, i.e. within 4 years of her joining the said post on the basis of Ph.D Degree
- 9. The screening committee has also cleared the case of Dr Reena Rani for the promotion to the grade pay of Rs. 8000/-.on 19 July, 2017.

Proceedings of the Enquiry Committee

The Enquiry committee held its first meeting in the Committee Room of BPSMV Khanpur Kalan on December 16, 2019 to deliberate on the nature and content of the complaint and to decide the modus operandi for conducting the enquiry. The committee decided a) to meet both Dr.Reena Rani and Dr. Varuna Dahiya to hear their versions in person and b) to ask the Deputy Registrar's office (ET Branch) to furnish the following relevant documents:

• Eligibility Qualification as approved by the university EC or Board of Governors for the said post at the time of advertisement

- Application Form of Dr Reena Rani along with all the documents submitted by her in the university for the said post
- Proceedings/Report of Screening Committee of application of Dr Reena Rani for the said post
- Copy of the Appointment Letter issued to Dr Reena Rani

The committee also interacted with both of them so that they could present their position/case in this regard in person before the committee. Given below are the summary of the statements given by them:

Statement of Dr Varuna

Dr Varuna reiterated her stand of allegation against Dr Reena Rani. She told how Dr Reena not only had concealed the important information on her Ph.D. at the time of selection for which she claimed the benefit and was accorded as well later on but she also got promotion in the grant of AGP Rs.7000/- and Rs.8000/- in violation of the service rules and regulations in the university (See Annexure –IV for her written statement).

Statement of Dr Reena Rani

Dr Reena Rani emphasized in her statement before the committee that she had not concealed any fact at the time of appointment and she had attached the copies of all the certificates including M.Ed., M.Phil and Ph.D. with her application form. She informed the committee that she did her Ph.D. in Hindi in 2007, M.Ed. in 2006 and M.Phil Degree through Distance mode in 2007. She had obtained 'No Objection Certificate' from the Registrar, Gurukul Kangri Vishwavidyalaya, Haridwar to pursue her M.Ed. through Distance mode along with her Ph.D. (Hindi) which she was pursuing in Regular Mode. Further, she stated that as per information Brochure of C.D.L.U. Sirsa. "Dual Degree in Distance education is allowed with one regular course". Hence there is no violation of rules and no concealment of any fact on her part. The advantage of Ph.D. was given by the university as per state Govt rules. (See Annexure –V for her written statement).

In response to the documents sought from the office, the D.R. (ET branch) gave the following to the committee:

- 1. A letter from the Incharge ITTR on the subject of Application Forms of the selected candidates in Education in 2008 clearly mentions that the ITTR office had received 95 pages from Est. (Teaching) vide letter Dated 3/08/2011 in respect of Dr Anu, Dr Varuna, Dr Rekha and Dr Reena Rani. Out of 95 pages only two pages No 75 and 76 of Job application of Dr Reena Rani were received. No other Document has been received till 22.11.2021, the date of the letter sent to ET branch (Teaching) (See Annexure -VI).
- 2. Qualifications for the post of Lecturer approved in the EC/BOM meeting was provided partially and not complete document. Only one single page was provided and that too does not mention the details of qualification.

Regarding the proceedings of the meeting of Screening committee of the Application Forms for the selection of the said post, the office verbally told the committee that the proceedings are not traceable from the record.

The committee concluded the meeting with the decision to meet again only after the office arranges all the required and sought for documents related to the case and inform the Chair of the committee to fix the date of the next meeting.

The second meeting of the Enquiry committee was held on February 10, 2022. The D.R. office was asked to inform Dr Reena Rani and Dr Varuna to be present for the meeting. The Est. office provided the personal file of Dr Reena Rani for verification of the facts under question. The committee asked Dr Reena Rani to explain the reason for not mentioning the Ph.D Degree in her Application form for the said post. Dr Reena Rani told that since she could not get provisional certificate of Ph.D. on the same day of her viva-voce exam that was held on September 24, 2007. She herself told that she had applied for the post on September 28, 2007. So she did not mention the year of award of Ph.D. (See Annexure –VII for her written statement).

On enquiring from Dr Varuna about the specific reason for her complaint, the committee was told by her that consequent upon the advantage of Ph.D Degree accorded to Dr Reena Rani, her (Dr Varuna's) inter-se seniority in the Institute has been effected, though she has nothing personal against Dr Reena Rani.

D.R. (ET branch) informed the committee that after the receipt of the complaint against Dr Reena Rani, the university had sought information from Gurukul Kangri Vishwavidyalaya regarding issue of NOC to Dr Reena Rani for completing her M.Ed. from Panjab University, Chandigarh after her registration for Ph.D. in Gurukul Kangri Vishwavidyalaya in 2005. The university also asked Gurukul Kangri Vishwavidyalaya to provide the information regarding the award of Ph.D Degree. The Assistant Registrar (Academic session) of Gurukul Kangri Vishwavidyalaya vide letter No. Reg No Acad/Res/2018-19/80 Dated 30/01/2018 informed that Reena Rani was awarded Ph.D Degree in 2007. Also an NOC dated 27/07/2005 was issued to Dr Reena Rani by the vishwavidyalaya regarding her pursuing M.Ed. through correspondence from Panjab University, Chandigarh. (See Annexure –VIII)

The D.R. of ET branch could not provide the following to the committee:

- Eligibility Qualification not as a proper document as approved by the university EC or Board of Governors for the said post at the time of advertisement
- Proceedings/Report of Screening Committee of application of Dr Reena Rani for the said post
- Copy of Interview Letter issued to Dr Reena Rani

The third meeting of the committee was held on 15.09.2022 to finalize the report.

Committee's Observations on Statements, Application Form and other Documents including Dr. Reena Rani personal file.

- 1. As per the record, the Ph.D. column in the application form of Dr Reena Rani submitted for the said post mention only the name of the University and not the year of its award.
- 2. As per the record (from her personal file), her viva-voce exam for Ph.D. was held on September 24, 2007. Dr Reena Rani had applied for the Post on September 28, 2007.
- 3. In her application form for the said post, any information regarding the year of the award of Ph.D. is missing. The facts regarding conduct of viva-vice or year of Ph.D. are not mentioned.
- 4. In her personal interaction with the committee, Dr Reena Rani denied the allegation of hiding the material information and told that she could not get the provisional certificate of Ph.D. by the date she had applied for the said post.
- 5. D.R. (ET branch) could not furnish the complete application form along with the documents attached by her at the time of application for the post.
- 6. The concerned office did not provide the Proceedings of the screening committee of the applications for the said post

The approved and complete eligibility qualifications for the said post have also not been provided to the committee

Based on the personal interaction with both Dr. Reena Rani and Dr. Varuna Dahiya and after having examined the documents furnished by the ET branch, the committee arrives at the following findings:

- 1. Dr Reena Rani applied for the said Post on September 28, 2007.
- 2. The interviews for the post were held on March 20, 2008 after a gap of almost six months.
- 3. Dr Reena Rani joined the university on March 29, 2008 consequent upon the issue of appointment letter dated 29.03.2008 to her.
- 4. According to her, she had submitted the copy of Provisional Ph.D. certificate along with other certificates at the time of joining.
- 5. The Provisional Ph.D certificate dated September 24, 2007 (the date of her viva voce for Ph.D) is available in her personal file.
- 6. The copy of Ph.D Degree dated June 7, 2008 is also placed in her personal file.
- 7. Dr. Reena Rani applied for the grant of four advance increment for Ph.D on September 03, 2008 and was consequently granted the same vide letter dated November 14, 2008.
- 8. She was awarded grade Pay of Rs. 7000/- w.e.f. March 30, 2012 on the completion of 4 years of service.
- 9. Benefit / advantage of Ph.D Degree at the time of appointment has been granted to her.
- 10. Dr Reena Rani's case for the grant of grade pay of Rs. 8000/- (Stage II to III) w.e.f. March 29, 2017 has been recommended by the Screening committee. As per official record screening / interview for this purpose was held on 19 July, 2017. But recommendations are pending subject to the approval of EC.

In the absence of many relevant documents, the committee fails to arrive at any conclusion whether the concealment of facts regarding Ph.D in Job application was deliberate with some motive on the part of Dr. Reena Rani or not. If the committee goes by the statement of Dr Reena Rani in the second meeting (Though in the first meeting, she had told the committee that she had attached the copies of all the certificates including M.Ed., M.Phil and Ph.D. with her application form) said that she did not have the provisional certificate by the time of her application. Only the office of ET branch can verify the situation so as to the status of the submission of her documents and the time of submission. Another point of contention in the complaint was that Dr Reena Rani earned three degrees in higher education – M.Ed., M.Phil. and Ph.D. during a two year period time from 2005 to 2007. The NOC from Gurukul Kangri obtained is regarding M.Ed pursuing simultaneously with Ph.D. but NOC for M.Phil was either not obtained from Gurukul Kangri Vishwavidyalaya by her or not considered worth mention. She also did not give any information to the University in this regard.

In the light of the above observations and findings, the committee is of the view that an appropriate decision and action may be taken by the competent authority of the BPSMV Khanpur Kalan accordingly as per the university rules and norms in this regard.

LEGAL OPINION

Sub: Dr. Reena Rani, ITTR

The instant file has been put up before the undersigned for seeking legal opinion on the issue. The proposition herein before is "whether two parallel degrees one through regular mode and another through distance education mode can be undertaken simultaneously by a student?" It becomes necessary to frame the issues so as to deal with the proposition with clarity.

- (1) Whether UGC has framed any such rules clarifying the position?
- (2) Whether it has been left to the respective institutions or councils to take a call on the issue?

The brief factual history of the issue is narrated below:-

On a complaint by Dr. Varuna (Assistant Professor) against Dr. Reena Rani that she has concealed material facts at the time of taking appointment for the post of Lecturer in 2007-08 and for grant of AGP of Rs. 8000/- in 2017. She further alleged that she has done two parallel degrees simultaneously, which is the apparent violation of the UGC and Distance Education Council norms. So far as the terms and conditions in the advertisement for the said posts are concerned, it is stated that the advertisement w.r.t qualifications of the said post only prescribes in general terms stating "as per UGC terms".

Coming to the first issue:- It is observed that to the extent framing of any rules on the issue by the UGC is concerned, there is no document on record to clarify the position in clear terms. However, Annexure-5 relied

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upon by the complainant is concerned, it is again unclear and is silent on

the specific question of pursuing of two degrees one through regular and

another through distance mode. It requires lot of clarification and it pertains

to the year 2017. Whereof the controversy of Dr. Reena Rani pertains to the

year 2005, 2006 & 2007, i.e. the year of doing respective degrees by her.

Therefore, the rule position relating to these years has to be seen.

Coming to the second issue, so far as doing regular Ph.D. course is

concerned the candidate Dr. Reena Rani had taken NOC from the Gurukul

Kangri University for pursuing her M.Ed from Panjab University through

distance education mode. The said M.Ed degree got over in April 2006.

After which she enrolled herself for pursuing her M.Phil from CDLU,

Sirsa through distance education mode in October 2006 and it is provided in

the prospectus of the said University that a candidate can pursue another

course simultaneously. Significantly, what is noticed is; it is one regular

degree and one degree through distance education mode, which was being

pursued by Dr. Reena Rani at a given time.

It assumes significance to note that Dr. Reena Rani after being appointed

to the post of Lecturer, was due for grant of AGP benefit in light of her Ph.D.

degree after completion of four years of service, She was given that benefit of

AGP 7000, finally when her case for grant of benefit of 2nd AGP was to be

considered, a complaint was received raising objections on the same on the

ground of concealment of these facts at the time of taking appointment by

her. It is important to note that a committee on the instructions of the then

V.C. was constituted, but there could be no clear cut decision as is evident

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from the perusal of record. The finding was arrived at by leaving the controversy to the respective competent authority to take the decision.

From the perusal of the enquiry file and in the absence of required documents, it is difficult to arrive at any clear conclusion based on rule position. As neither there are any clear guidelines by the UGC, pertaining to the said year nor do the respective Universities/ Councils granting degrees through distance mode debar pursuing of one degree through regular mode simultaneously with another degree through distance mode.

Therefore, in the given background and to balance the equity, it is opined that the benefit of AGP on fulfilment of required conditions may be given to Dr. Reena Rani.

The revised ACP rules received from Finance Department, Govt. of Haryana vide order No 1/83/2008-1PR (FD) of 04.03.2014 and Finance Department Notification No. 1/20/2016 (ACP)-5PR (FD) dated 28.10.2016 of general ACP structure were also placed before the committee by the branch for ready reference.

Proceedings:

The committee considered the ACP cases of the following teachers of MSM Institute of Ayurveda and after going through the ACP rules, it is found that the corresponding grade of 6000 & 6400 merged with GP 6600 & placed in FPL-11 in 7TH CPC. Hence, the Committee recommended 1st ACP of teachers at Sr. 2 to 9 in ACPL-16 instead of ACPL-15 as per ACP rules and recommended remaining cases as vetted by the Accounts Branch:

Kindly to the subject cited above, In this connection, it is submitted that Bhagat Phool Singh Mahila Vishwavidyalaya Khanpur Kalan (hereinafter referred as the University) absorbed the staff (teaching and Non-Teaching) working in Educational Institutes administered by Kanya Gurukul Khanpur Kalan and Haryana Mahasabha Bhainswal Kalan (hereinafter referred as the Private Educational Society) as per FD Memo No. 20/1-2006 UNP(1) dated 21.09.2006 after establishment of the University w.e.f. 18.08.2006 (Annexure-1). Further, the University rationalized services of the staff (Teaching and Non-Teaching) working under Self-Financing Scheme in educational institutions administered by erstwhile private educational society as per memo of the FD after framing a rationalization policy consequent upon sanction of post for such employees by the Finance Department, Government, of Haryana w.e.f. 27.02.2009 and later on (Annexure-2).

The grant-in-aid staff absorbed in the University has been given benefit of ACP under HCS (ACP) Rules from date of their initial appointment in the private educational society till date. Further, the University granted benefit of ACP under HCS (ACP) Rules to the staff working in Selffinancing Scheme by counting services of such employees who were appointed in the pay grade by the private educational society till date.

Recently, Hon'ble High Court for States of Punjab and Haryana in CWP No. 11886 of 2004 titled Haryana Adhayapak Sangh Vs. Kanya Gurukul Khanpur Kalan and others (wherein the University becomes party in place of the private educational society by virtue of the University Act) , decided that grant in-Aid staff of Private educational institutions are not entitled for ACP under HCS (ACP) Rules at page no 27, 28 &30 (Annexure-3).

In light of the above facts and decision, I am directed to request you to kindly clarify whether the grant- in-aid staff absorbed in the university shall be entitled to ACP under HCS (ACP) Rules for their services rendered in the private educational society in light of the decision of Hon'ble High Court in CWP No. 11686 of 2004. Further, it may also be clarified whether the Self-Financing Scheme Staff rationalized in the University shall be entitled to ACP under (ACP) Rules for their services rendered in the private educational society in light of the above decision. The above clarifications may be provided with concurrence of the Finance Department, Government of Haryana, please.



The University vide office order No. BPSMV/EN-1/23/1176-79 dated 06.06.2023 constituted the committee to make its recommendations with regard to existing promotion policy of non-teaching staff from the post of Assistant onwards. The committee perused the representation dated 05.05.2023 to revise existing ratio of promotion of non-teaching staff from 75:25 (75% by promotion and 25% by direct recruitment) to 80:20 (80% by promotion and 20% by direct recruitment) from the post of Assistant onwards.

The committee noted that the Executive Council in its 41st meeting of Executive Council held on 20.02.2015 resolved to revise the promotion policy of non-teaching staff with a ratio of 75:25 (75% by promotion and 25% by direct recruitment) from the post of Assistant up to the level of Assistant Registrar excluding the post of Regional Centre of BPSMV at Lula Ahir in district Rewari and Kharal in district Jind and promotion from class IV to Class III employees in ratio of 20:80 (20% by promotion and 80% by direct recruitment for appointment to the post of Clerk-cum-Data Entry Operator) after revising the earlier resolution No. 18 of EC dated 21.02.2013 providing the ratio of 50:50 (50% direct recruitment and 50% by promotion) whereas the ratio for the post of Assistant Registrar to Deputy Registrar continued 50:50 (50% direct recruitment and 50% by promotion).

The committee also noted that there is provision of 100% promotion from Assistant to Deputy Registrar in M.D. University, Rohtak vide resolution No. 20 of 262th Executive Council meeting held on 30.03.2018 of that University.

The Committee after detailed deliberation is of the considered view that making a provision of 100% promotion from Assistant to Assistant Registrar will restrict the entry of future talent which shall be detrimental to the growth of the

However, the committee is of considered opinion that the existing ratio of promotion may be enhanced from 75:25 (75% by promotion and 25% by direct recruitment) to 80:20 (80% by promotion and 20% by direct recruitment) from the post of Assistant up to the level of Assistant Registrar which will afford better avenues of promotion to in-house candidates without hampering the growth of the University. Further, the existing ratio for promotion the post of Assistant Professor University. Further, the existing ratio for promotion the post of Assistant Professor to Deputy Registrar and class IV to Class III employee may remain unchanged as already decided by the Executive Council earlier. The proposed ratio for promotion may be made applicable on joint seniority after inclusion of the posts of Regional Centre at Kharal in District Jind and Regional Centre, Lula Ahir in District Rewari alongwith posts of the constituent Institutions/Colleges.
