In the first week of may 2022 cadets of our university along with gardeners cleaned the flower beds of the university so that new saplings could be grown.

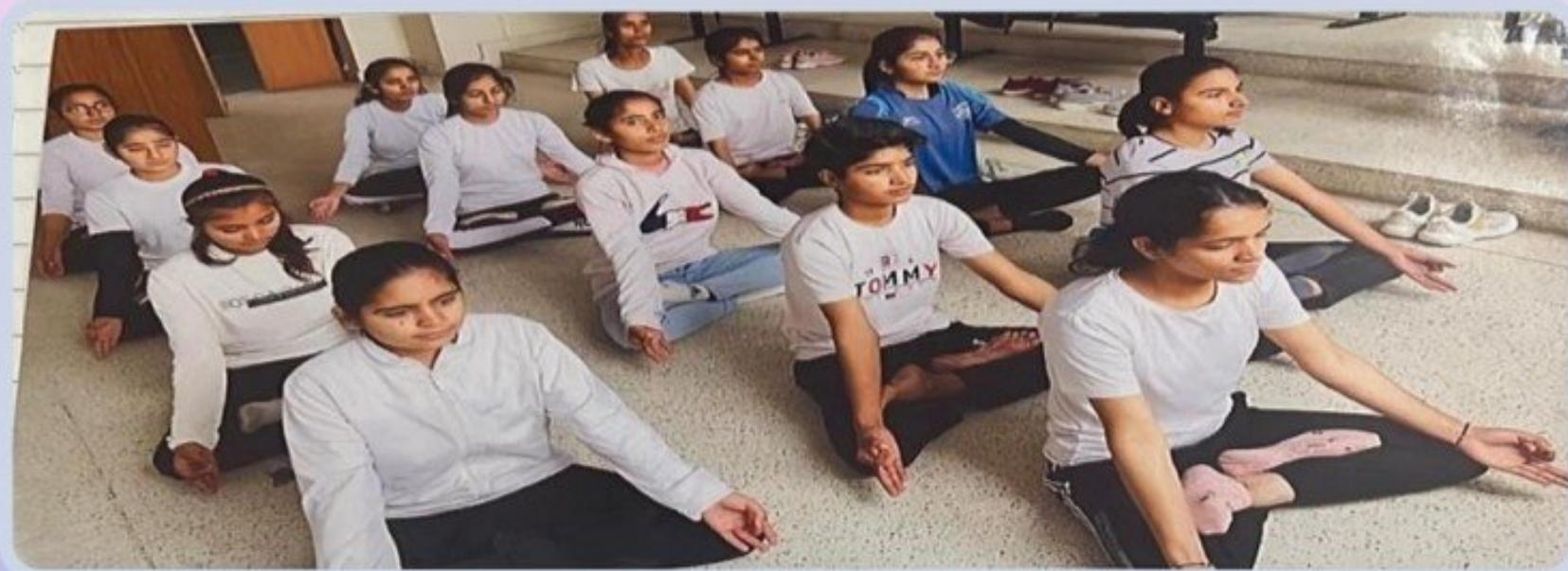

गोहाना, 3 अक्टूबर (अरोड़ा) : बी.पी.एस. महिला विश्वविद्यालय में प्रथम वर्ष की छात्राओं के लिए एन.सी.सी. यूनिट की 22 सीटों के लिए चयन प्रक्रिया शुरू हो गई है।

चयन प्रक्रिया का आयोजन एन.सी.सी. प्रभारी डॉ. राजेश हुड्डा और एन.सी.सी. अधिकारी डॉ. अनु लठवाल ने किया। डॉ. अनु लठवाल ने बताया कि यह चयन प्रक्रिया मुरघल स्थित दीनबंधु छोटूराम विश्वविद्यालय में आयोजित की जा रही है। महिला विश्वविद्यालय की 125 छात्राओं ने मुरघल पहुंचकर चयन प्रक्रिया में भाग लिया।

## REPORT ON ONE DAY WORKSHOP ON SOCIAL VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN

Women Study Centre in collaboration with Student's Welfare, B P S Mahila Vishwavidhalya organised one day workshop on "Social Violence against Women" on 12<sup>th</sup> December 2022. Dr. Vandana Dave, Research Officer, women study centre, Kurukshetra University was the resource person of the workshop and students of various departments of the university participated in this workshop. Dr. Dave raised the subject of violence and discrimination against women and also deliberated on the Protection of Women against Domestic Violence Act, 2005 (PWDVA) which is a civil and secular law that addresses the needs of women in situations of violence and applies to women of all communities. She explained the definition of violence as described by Act to include mental, verbal, physical and economic abuse. It is applicable not only to married women but all women in a family as well as women in relationships akin to marriage. She highlighted that even today women are facing terrible evils and explained four types of domestic violence. She also shared that Haryana is infamous for crimes against women and its share in sexual crimes in India is 2.4 per cent, more than Punjab and Himachal. Around 32 per cent women are victims of spousal violence. Besides, 88 cases of child sex abuse, and 93 cases of rape had been registered every month since 2015. She shared that according to the National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) report 'Crime in India-2021' nearly 18 per cent accused facing trial for committing a crime against women were convicted last year in Haryana when the pendency of such cases rose to 93 per cent even as almost five women a day were raped across the state, She stressed on the fact that despite of many international and national women's rights movement, women and girls around the world are still married as children or trafficked into forced labor and sex slavery. They are denied the access to education and political participation and some are trapped in conflicts where rape is perpetrated as a weapon of war.



She mentioned that around the world, deaths related to pregnancy and childbirth are high, and women are prevented from making their personal choices in their private lives. Though, many concrete steps are being taken by the government to prevent violence against women but still people with criminal instincts and anti-women thinking do heinous acts including sexual exploitation, rape etc. Dr. Dave also explained in detail about various sections of IPC with the gathering. The session was concluded by making the students aware about their



rights and responsibilities. It is imperative that girls studying in the higher education institutions should make best use of education and empower themselves holistically. She further suggested that in order to prevent violence against women, it is imperative that children about respect, gender equality and positive attitudes towards girls should be encouraged. There is a need that gender equality should be taught in the schools so that girls and women start getting respect at micro level. Role-modelling respect is the best way to teach children about respectful relationships. The programme ended with vote of thanks by Dr.Manju Panwar, Director Women Study Centre.

## **REPORT ON ONE DAY WORKSHOP ON WOMEN'S EMPOWERMENT: KEY TO ATTAINING SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT (AGENDA 2030)**

A workshop on women's empowerment key to attaining sustainable development (agenda 2030) was organized by women study center, B. P. S. Mahila Vishwavidhalaya, Khanpur Kalan on 27<sup>th</sup> September 2022. Dr. Bhakti Devi from Rishihood University and Dr. Rajeshwary Malik, Professor of Management and organization, Woxsen University, researcher United Nations University were the main resource persons of the workshop. At the outset, Dr Manju Panwar, Director Women Study Centre welcome the distinguished guests and brief about the objective of organizing this workshop by emphasizing that achieving gender equality and women's empowerment are the integral to each of the 17 goals. Rights of women and girls can only be ensured if all the goals of SDGs are in tune with gender equality on sustainable basis.



After that Dr. Bhakti Devi from Rishihood University stressed on the importance of water scarcity problem because of which women have to suffer a lot. She added that due to lack of proper water management, many women have to bring water from far away. She suggested that rainwater should be collected for sustainable use.



She said that water covers 71% of the earth's surface and it's vital for all known forms of life. Freshwater is a scarce resource. Only 2.5% of the 1.4 Billion of water on earth is freshwater fit for human consumption and most of this is inaccessible. She mentioned that water conservation includes all the policies, strategies and activities to sustainably manage the natural resource of fresh water and conserve it for future generation. She put her point with the statistics that at present only about 0.08 percent of all the world's freshwater is exploited by mankind in ever increasing demand for sanitation, drinking, manufacturing, leisure and agriculture. She concluded her lecture that keeping in mind the scarcity of water, need of the hour is to conserve the water and use it consciously.

Dr. Rajeshwary Malik, Professor of Management and organization, Woxsen University , researcher United Nations University focused her presentation on the problem of declining sex ratio in Haryana. She mentioned that despite of many schemes and programmes on women empowerment and innumerable workshop and seminars on this theme, declining sex ratio is issue which needs immediate attention. She stressed on the fact that women play an imperative role in making a nation progressive and guide it towards development. Providing quality education to women is the prerequisite requirement for nation building.



The workshop was very useful in terms of making students aware about the choices they need to make about their life for social transformation. There is no doubt that if a man is educated then only one person is educated but if a woman is educated then whole generation is empowered and educated. Women empowerment is the pivotal part in any society. Education as means of empowerment of women can bring about a positive attitudinal change. It is therefore crucial for the socioeconomic and political progress of any county, providing education to women is must.

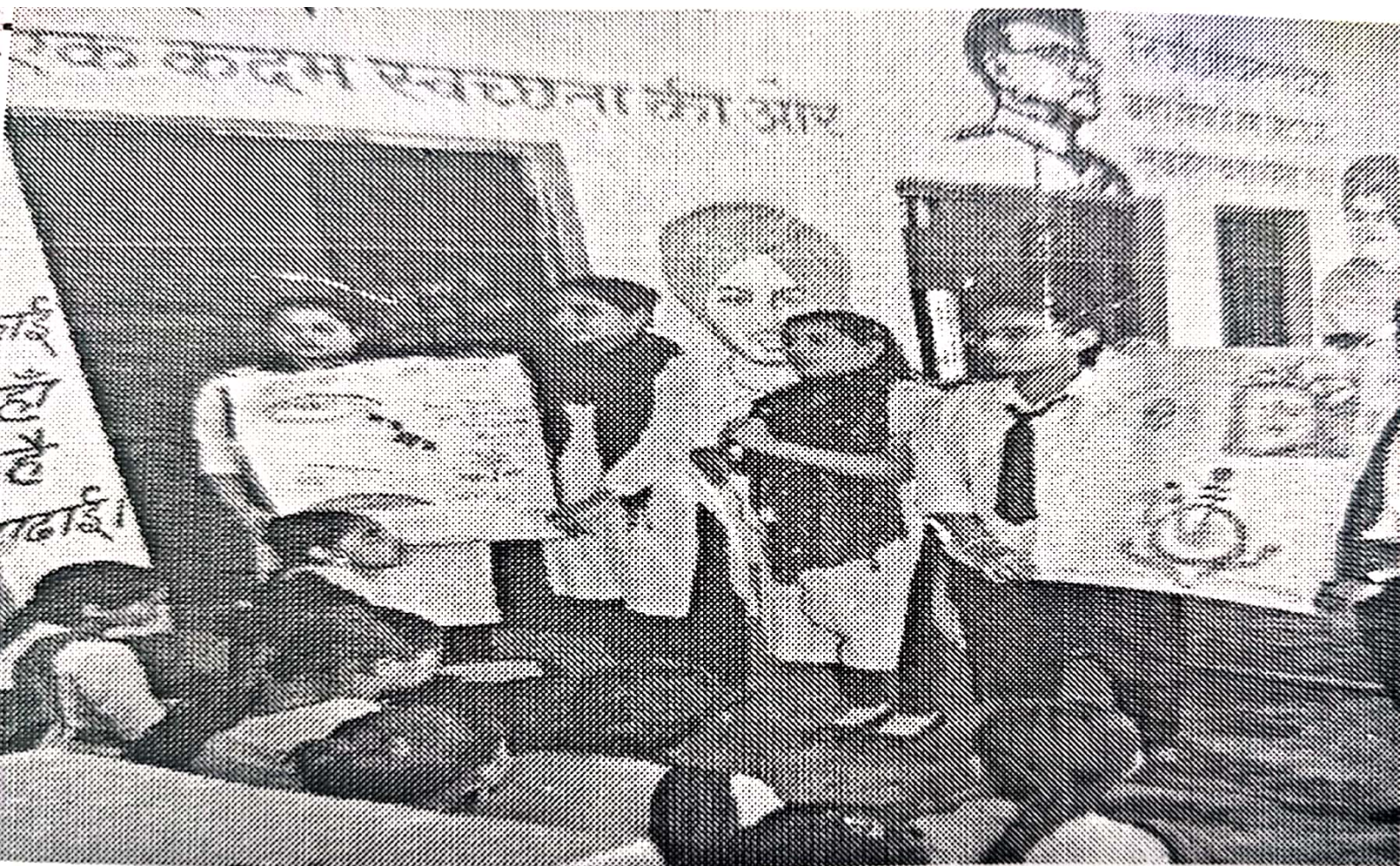

### **Workshop on Women Entrepreneurships through Self Help Group in Rural Area.**



To set up a functional and sustainable model of ‘Zero Waste to Landfill & Clean-Green-Pollution Free Campus’ involving the residents, students & other staff and ensure compliance of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016, Haryana Non-biodegradable Waste Management Act-1998, Plastic Waste Management (amended) Rules, 2021 & 2022, C&D Waste Management Rules, 2016, E- Waste Management Rules, 2016 and Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules (Amended), 2018 and Hon’ble NGT orders from time to time in letter & spirit, this Comprehensive Action Plan has been prepared and to be executed from date of signing of MoU w.e.f. 11-02-2023.

## **OBJECTIVE**

Skilling up students and staff for low cost environment management practices for attaining and sustaining ‘**Zero Waste to Landfill & Clean-Green-Pollution Free Environment**’ and ownership creation among them for their contribution in ‘**Sustainable Development**’.

### **1. BACKGROUND**

Bhagat Phool Singh Mahila Vishwavidyalaya is the ‘dream come true’ of Bhagat Phool Singh Ji, who established a Gurukul for girls at Khanpur Kalan in 1936. Even after the demise of Bhagat Phool Singh, his equally dynamic daughter Subhashini Ji not only took control of Gurukul but worked vigorously in expanding the Gurukul in terms of its various constituent institutions like BPS Memorial Girls’ College (1967), BPS College of Education (1968), MSM



Ayurvedic College (1973), BPS Mahila Polytechnic (1984), TIG Bhainswal Kalan(1999) and PSD Girls' Law College (2003).

The State Government under the leadership of Shri Bhupinder Singh Hooda, then Hon'ble Chief Minister of Haryana took cognizance and upgraded the erstwhile Gurukul to the status of a University exclusively for women in August 2006 and christened it as Bhagat Phool Singh Mahila Vishwavidyalaya, which happens to be the first State Women University of North India. Since then BPSMV has undergone a complete transformation; a 75 years old Gurukul started with only three girls has turned into a modern University with approximately 7000 girls on its rolls studying in various programmes.

### **Salient Features**

- BPSMV is spread over lush green, pollution free 500 acres of networked & safe campus, juxtaposing tradition with modernity. BPSMV is the first State Women University of North India providing education from KG to PhD level.

- BPSMV has established state of the art Language Labs and Staff Training and Research Institute for Teaching of English.
- BPSMV has signed MOUs with many foreign universities and other organizations of repute.
- Free placement and personality development assistance is provided to all the enrolled students.

- BPSMV organized Women Youth Parliament to hone leadership skills of students.
- BPSMV has implemented all the good practices pertaining to academic, sports, cultural areas and sustainable development through environment protection & conservation.

### **Mission – Zero Waste to Landfill & Clean –Green Pollution Free Campus**

Under the leadership of Vice Chancellor Prof Sudesh and Registrar Dr Neelam Malik, BPSMV, it has been decided to prepare & execute a functional and sustainable model of ‘Zero Waste to Landfill & Clean-Green-Pollution Free Campus’



and reputed NGO Green Earth – Organization for Environment, Health, Safety & Sanitation, Kurukshetra (Key Resource Center (KRC) and Sector Partner, GoI, Department of Drinking Water & Sanitation, New Delhi) will be involved for this purpose. A MoU has been signed between the Management of the Institutions and Green Earth NGO- Kurukshetra for preparation & successful implementation of the Action plan. Presently, around 800 – 1000 KG waste is generated per day from all activities in the University Campus.

## 2. OBSERVATION

Team of Green Earth NGO (Dr Naresh Bhardwaj and Monika Bhardwaj), Green Earth NGO, Kurukshetra visited the University Campus to see the present practices being adopted in the whole campus on dated 11-02-2023. Dr Bhupender Singh, Dr Dipali (BPSMV), Dr Naresh Bhardwaj and Monika Bhardwaj



(Green Earth) visited the whole campus and see the practices related to environment including waste disposal, sanitation and hygiene. Really, this is very

beautiful campus having properly designed buildings and well organized offices surrounded by lush green dense forestation. Secondly, fruit plants of various species have been grown to support the bio-diversity. The key observations during the site visit are as under:

## **2.1 SOURCES OF WASTE GENERATION**

- Residents (227)
- Hostels (11) & Strength (2262)
- Messes (7)
- Canteen/ tea stalls (3)
- Shopping Complex (15 shops)
- Departments/ Institutions/ Centers (23)
- Bank/ ATM/ Post Office

- Parks/ Gardens/ Play Ground

## **2.2 PRESENT STATUS**

- Mixed Waste is being dumped in open in a trench surrounded with eucalyptus trees as contract of outsource agency deployed for this purpose already expired and the University is in process of setting up of own in-situ waste management system with the support of Green Earth – Kurukshetra.
- Garbage Bin placed near residents was found full of mixed waste
- Mix waste was found in dust bins installed in parks and canteen etc.
- Horticulture Waste is lifted & transported with Tractor-Traullies and dumped in a trench surrounded with eucalyptus trees
- Single Use Plastics/ Plastic Carry bags are being used

- Horticulture Waste is also burnt in open
- Littering was also observed in some places in the campus

**3. SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT** (coupled with segregation of waste at source mandatorily)

‘Waste to Resource Unit’ of size 30’ x 40’ having 5 compost cells of size 10’ L x 5’ B x 4’ H each for Wet Waste and 5 Chambers of size 5’ L, 5’ B x 4’ H for Dry Waste to be required nearest to the waste generating units.

**3.1 KITCHEN WASTE** (generated from Residents/ Mess/ Hostel/ Canteen etc)

**Management Activities**

- 1) Aerobic Composting by constructing Compost Unit having six Honeycomb Aerobic Cells proposed to be constructed near Power House.
- 2) Usage, promotion and sale of compost.

**3.2 HORTICULTURE WASTE** (generated from parks/ gardens/ play ground etc)

**Management Activities**

- 1) Natural composting in the Compost Units created with living hedge/ wire mesh in decentralized manner to cut off unnecessary cost of transportation.
- 2) Usage, promotion and sale of compost.

**3.3 PLASTIC & OTHER DRY WASTE** (generated from whole campus)

**Management Activities**

- 1) Prohibition/ elimination of Single Use Plastics/ thermocol Items (disposal items including water bottles/ plastic bags/ plastic file covers/ plastic wrappers on gifts/ prizes/ buckeyes/ plastic-thermocol models/ assignments etc)
- 2) Installation of Transparent Boxes for Used Pen Collection & plastic Bottles at the common places

- 3) Installation of Jaali Box for plastic wrappers & other dry at some common places
- 4) Management of dry waste in small sized Material Recovery Facility (MRF) proposed to be constructed near Power House.
- 5) Re-use & preparation of Best out of Waste Park
- 6) Storage, Bailing and Channelization of dry waste
- 7) Regular picking of dry waste from parks/ green belts etc instead of sweeping
- 8) Boards at prime locations regarding SUP Free and Litter Free Campus

**3.4 SANITARY & BIO-MEDICAL WASTE** (generated from Toilets, Hostel & Health Facility)

**Management Activities**

- 1) Sanitary waste to be buried or incinerated through nearby Bio-medical Waste Processing Facility
- 2) Bio-medical waste will be disposed off as per Rules.

**3.5 ELECTRONIC WASTE** (generated from offices/ labs, include computer systems, lap tops, mobile phones, chargers, LCD screen etc.)

**Management Activities**

- 1) Installation of collection Box/ Room
- 2) Channelization of e-waste through Authorized Recyclers/ Dealers

**3.6 CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION WASTE MANAGEMENT** (generated from C&D activities)

**Management Activities**

- 2) Re-utilization/ Channelization

- Plants of various local species (fruits/ flowers/ shed) will be grown for environment sustainability and economic gains.
- Development Herbal Garden
- Development Micro Forest
- Development of Plant Nursery

### **5.6 Habitat for Flora & Fauna**

- Whole campus will be developed as a balanced ecosystem focusing on support to the biodiversity (flora & fauna)
- Adoption of kitchen gardening involving of students & staff

### **5.7 Best Out of Waste Park**

- Various Waste Materials will be used for creating various useful items for developing of Best out of Waste Park

- Usage of Single Use Plastic/Thermocol (Non-biodegradable) items in whole campus
- Littering in parks/ class rooms etc
- Mixing of wet & dry waste
- Dumping of waste
- Burning of waste (dry & horticulture)

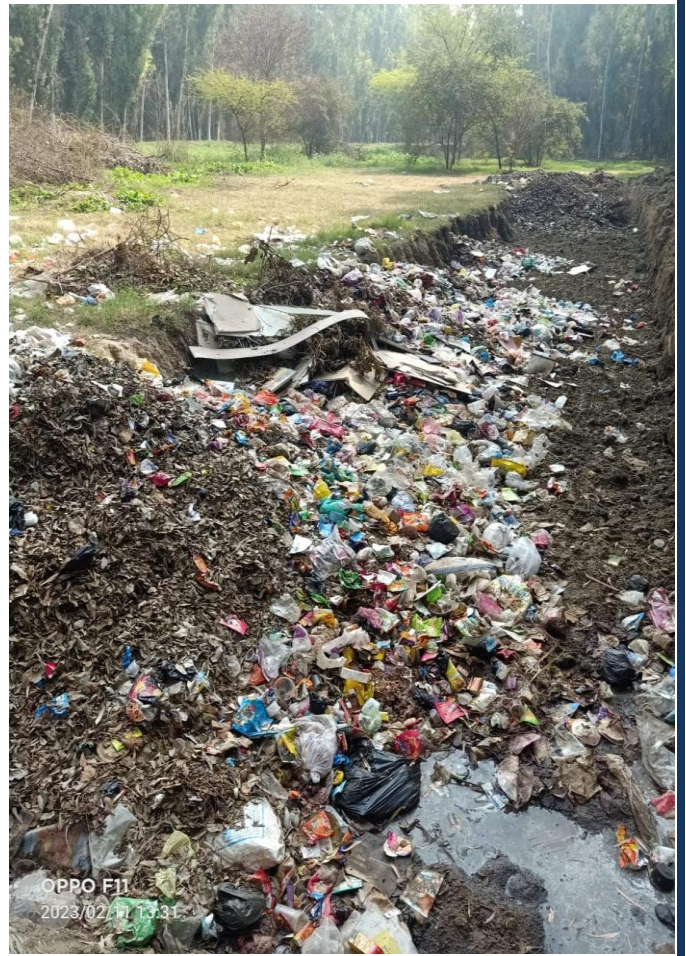

**GREEN EARTH – ORGANIZATION FOR ENVIRONMENT, HEALTH, SAFETY & SANITATION (Key Resource Center & Sector Partner – GoI, Ministry of Jal Shakti, Department of Drinking Water & Sanitation)**, Shopping Complex, Teka Market, New Shanti Nagar, Kurukshetra – Pehowa Road, Kurukshetra, Haryana - 136118 (herein referred as '**Party No –II**') of other part;


The Party No I and Party No II are hereinafter collectively referred to as "Parties" and severally each as 'Party'. This MoU/ Agreement shall be effective from date of signing ("**Effective Date**").

**IT IS NOW AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS UNDER:**

1. That both parties will work together for attaining and sustaining goal of '**Zero Waste to Landfill**' & '**Clean - Green – Pollution Free Campus**' in a befitting manner.
2. That the Party-II will provide technical/ handholding support to the Party-I for developing a low cost & sustainable waste management mechanism.
3. That the Party-II will provide facilities/ technical & administrative support to the students (Party-I) for successful completion in their internship in environment related subjects.
4. That both parties agreed to extend support of subject experts/ resource persons/ administrative teams to each – other as and when required for conducting capacity building programmes i.e. trainings, workshops, seminars, symposiums, camps, exposure visits, expert lectures and developing of various behaviour change IEC materials, training module and material development and documentation. The value of honorarium and other charges to be paid to the subject experts/ resource persons will be decided considering the conditions of projects/ works by both parties mutually. Both Parties will execute the various activities under this MoU on 'no profit – no loss' basis.

5. That both parties agreed to share the logistic support as and when required for conducting successfully capacity building programmes i.e. trainings, workshops, seminars, symposiums, camps, exposure visits, expert lectures and behaviour change IEC activities on environment protection & conservation including water, air, soil, sanitation & hygiene, health and safety from time to time. For this purpose, both Parties may get charges for providing logistic support to opposite party. The value of charges will be decided by considering the market rates by both parties mutually.
6. That the record of all activities including trainings/ IEC activities and other related works should be maintained in systematic manner.
7. That the names of both Parties will be advertised equally for the activities to be conducted under the ambit of this MoU.
8. That the MoU is signed initially for a period of three years which will be effective from date of signing of MoU. The stipulated period of MoU may further extend up to three years; however, this extension shall be purely on the basis of mutual consent of both parties.
9. That the parties may terminate MoU with prior notice of three months in writing which will be served at the registered address of opposite party.
10. That terms of MoU may be edited as per need with mutual consent of both parties in written.
11. That if any dispute arises between the Parties hereto during the subsistence of this MoU or thereafter, in connection with matters concerning therewith. The same shall be resolved through mutual consultation in amicable way.



1. **Title of the Practice: Mentoring System**

**2. Objectives:**

- To enable constructive interaction, guidance and mentorship of students
- To provide a reliable and comprehensive support system to motivate students to excel in both academic and non-academic fields and to make the most of their life at the institution
- To promote the values of responsibilities among students
- To encourage students for participation in different activities
- To improve the relationship between teacher and students through different activities
- To engage students in meaningful and positive activities
- To help fresh students in understanding the challenges and opportunities and develop a smooth transition to campus life.
- To counsel academically weak students and to play an important role in helping troubled students cope with academic, extra-academic and personal problems.
- To proactively try to identify problems of the general student populace and to bring them to the notice of the concerned authorities.
- To ensure regularity and punctuality of students through counseling sessions.

**3. Context**

The aim of higher education is to nurture the human being responsible for their own betterment but also capable of sustaining society and nature and ultimately for the development of a nation. Students from different backgrounds come for education. The institute environment is very new for them and they find the various difficulties in due course of their student life. Probably students fail to recognize the goals of the institute. The student should have knowledge and skills related to his/her work and as a good citizen. The atmosphere of trust and confidence in the campus creates an ideal environment for holistic development of the students. The role of the Mentor in the development of critical thinking and creative faculties among the students is that of a paramount importance in the formation and shaping the outlook and the attitude of the students. A mentor is an individual, usually elder, always more experienced, who helps guide another individual's development. The mentor's role is to guide, to give advice, and to support the mentee. A mentor can help a person (Mentee) improve his or her abilities and skills through observation, assessment, modeling, and by providing guidance. With this purpose a well-structured mentor-mentee system has been developed in the institution to facilitate the students to learn, unlearn and relearn the various skill sets to realize the full potential and growth. The teachers in the institution as a mentor have been allotted a number of students under this Mentor-Mentee system.

**4. The Practice**

All the students were divided into different mentoring groups. Each faculty member is the



mentor of a group of students allocated to him/ her by the Chairperson. Those faculties will continue to be the mentors for the same group of students till they passed out the course. The teacher mentor collects personal information from the ward without touching sensitive issues or forcing any information out of the wards and then provides the needed counseling to the wards. Critical issues are brought to the notice of the Head of the Department. The teacher meets the wards informally outside class hours as well and guides them regarding their career options. When the students enter the institute, they get lost in the crowd with too many students in the same class coming from different backgrounds these students face stress of complex course, peer pressure, and emotional immaturity. Therefore, it is the need of the hour to intervene and introduce mentorship program to this vulnerable group.

**5. Evidence of Success**

Faculty mentors play a crucial role in mentoring mentees. Students and their mentors share responsibility for ensuring productive and rewarding mentoring relationships. Both parties have a role to play in the success of mentoring. They provide both professional and personal advice to the students. They further give constructive feedback on writing, teaching and other elements of career design. They can serve to help students balance professional goals with their personal lives or give emotional encouragement during challenging times. The relationship between teacher and students was also strengthen through this activity.


**6. Problems Encountered and Resources Required**

Feedback is an important aspect of a mentoring program. It helps to understand the progress of the program, and the relationship between mentor and mentee. Dealing with mentee's inexperience (knowledge and skills), addressing mentee's misconceptions about course are the problems encountered.




Individual attention is needed for success of Mentoring system. So, more staff and resources are required for individual attention and personal touch.
