The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor welcomed all members to the meeting. Dr Shalini Attri, Associate Director, IQAC presented the Action Taken Report on the decisions of the 4<sup>th</sup> Meeting, underscoring the following points:

- The University has entered into several Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) with institutes of national/ international repute to enhance the foreign exchange programs for both students and faculty members.
- The proposal for a 30-hour/12-week online certificate course titled "Introductory Course in Ayurveda" for foreign nationals has been proposed by the MSM Institute of Ayurveda and is likely to be introduced soon after due approval from the Faculty and the Academic Council.
- To strengthen the connection between academia and industry, all departments have included members from industry in Boards of Studies (BOS) both at UG and PG level.
- The proposal for PG Programme in two departments of Ayurveda has been initiated. The NOC from state government has been issued for the same. The formalities related to Letter of Intent Inspection by NCIMS have been completed. The PG Programmes are likely to be rolled out w.e.f. the next session.
- Departmental Quality Assurance Cell (DQAC) has been constituted by all the departments.

Professor Ashok Verma, Director IQAC enumerated on the following achievements/activities of the university and the IQAC since the last meeting:

- Submission of the AQAR for the year 2022-23.
- Submission of the data for NIRF 2024 under five categories.
- 571st ranking of the university in the UI Green Metric rankings 2023.
- Mentorship of 52 colleges of Haryana for NAAC accreditation.
- Approval by the Additional Chief Secretary of the proposal of training of college and school teachers at STRITE, BPSMV.

The House lauded the university and the IQAC for their achievements and persistent efforts towards quality enhancement. Then, with the consent of the Chairperson, the formal agenda pertaining to various metrics of criterion 3 was taken up for discussion:

## 1. To consider promoting teachers for research through seed money.

Director IQAC drew the attention of the House to the revised benchmarks related to seed money. The committee discussed various strategies to encourage research through seed money among faculty members. It was suggested that the faculty members be promoted to undertake innovative, integrated research projects to further enhance research endeavors particularly in the fields such as environment, sustainability and engineering.

Mr. Mukesh Singh expressed his willingness to help the university develop a framework for waste management within the University campus. As a result, it was decided to schedule a meeting with Mr. Singh to discuss the framework for waste management in detail.

It was decided in the meeting that the Director Research would convene a meeting in the coming week with teachers who have been allocated seed money for research projectsto review the progress of the research projects and gather insights. Subsequently, the Director Research would submit a report to the IQAC detailing the status of these projects.

# 2. To devise mechanism for increasing the number of Patents in the Institution

Director IQAC underscored the need to devise mechanism for increasing the number of Patents in the Institution in the light of revised benchmarks in the concerned metric and said that faculty from the disciplines such as Sciences, Engineering, Ayurveda, Pharmacy and Hotel Management must be encouraged to file patents in their respective fields of research. Dr Yogender Malik suggested identify specific areas and the faculty with the potential for award of patent and they may be supported and encouraged to go for filing the patent. It was also decided that in order to encourage the faculty in this regard, patent filing fee may be paid by the university. Prof. Surender Mor suggested that further motivation in form of financial support for those faculty members who have been awarded a patent.

### 3. To discuss strategies for revenue generation through consultancy

The agenda on revenue generation through consultancy was deliberated upon at length. The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor proposed exploring consultancy opportunities in the social sector as a potential avenue for revenue generation and it was decided to create a team comprising the

- 1. Dean, Academic Affairs
- 2. Professor Ipshita Bansal, Department of Management
- 3. Dean, Faculty of Social Sciences
- 4. Chairperson, Department of Social Work
- 5. One representative from the Department of Ayurveda

The team would be tasked with investigating and identifying consultancy opportunities

Additionally, it was decided to meet with Professor Bhatt to pullout his expertise and insights into revenue generation strategies through consultancy.

Prof. Ipshita Bansal suggested providing consultancy services to nearby villages on various aspects, such as establishing e-chaupals. The Department of Social Work, in collaboration with specialized departments, could offer consultancy services tailored to the needs of the villagers.

Dr. Yogita Munjal emphasized upon tapping the resources such as National Medicinal Plants Board, Ministry of Ayushto increase consultancy through the faculty of Ayurveda.

## 4. To promote research projects from Non-Government Organization

In order to give a further fillip to the number of research projects awarded to the faculty, special focus is required on projects from Non-Government Organizations as the same counts towards overall score during accreditation. In this regard, Mr. Mukesh Singh suggested tapping small corporate entities as a potential avenue for collaboration and support for research projects and promised to extend support to the university which was well received by the House.

#### 5. Any other item with the permission of the chair

Dr. Yogender Malik suggested the University's participation in the Khelo India initiativeto facilitate the university's involvement in the program.Dr. Malik also drew attention to the upcoming Data Protection Act, thereby the necessity for the university to focus on data management practices and data sharing protocols.
